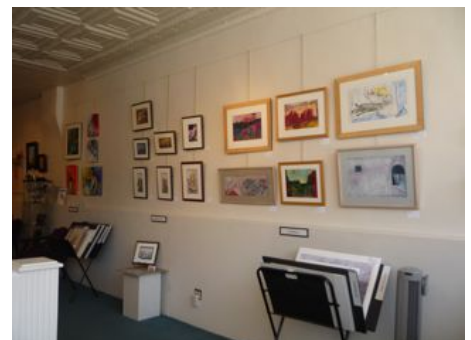
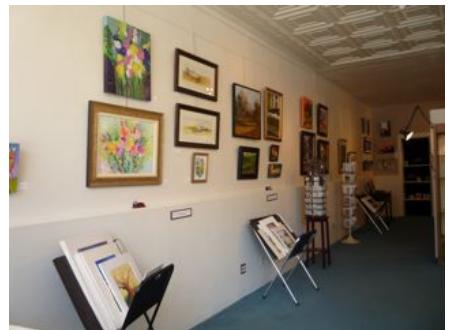
Co ART Gallery in Denver, CO

WORKER GUIDELINES

It was moved and passed by the membership at the January meeting that any Gallery worker who does not work their scheduled day or find a replacement to work for them, will be assessed a fee of \$25 if they do not show up for a half shift and \$50 if they were scheduled to work a full day shift.

In a board decision those having health issues are responsible for filling their work schedule, either by paying another member or trading with a member for a future date. Members who will work for pay are listed on each month's schedule. Payment is \$17.50 per shift.
